THE HOAX ORIGIN

Since Congress passed the 2018 Farm Bill with specific language allowing for the legal production of industrial hemp and non-intoxicating CBD, ambiguity in that law has created a perceived loophole that bad actors argue allows the production and retail sale of intoxicants derived from hemp. 


HOW WE DID IT: A SIMPLE TEST (OR ACTUALLY 55 OF THEM)

55 different products were purchased at fake dispensaries, smoke shops, gas stations, c-stores and CBD/vape stores in areas throughout Missouri, including: St. Louis, Lee's Summit, Maplewood, Kansas City, Nixa, Springfield, Ozark, Cameron, Affton, Ballwin, Independence, Clever, St. Joseph and Manchester.

These products were acquired, documented and tested to prove that unregulated stores across Missouri are, in fact, selling marijuana that is deceptively packaged and labeled as hemp. This is the crux of this Hemp Hoax report, which found that all 55 products purchased and tested are significantly intoxicating, deceptively packaged, labeled and merchandised to fool consumers, law enforcement, policymakers and prosecutors.

REVIEWING ALL THE WAYS MISSOURIANS ARE BEING TRICKED — AND HARMED.


HOAX #9: FALSELY ASSERTING REGULATION WOULD HURT MISSOURI HEMP FARMERS

Recently, USDA numbers show only 550 acres of hemp was grown in Missouri in 2024, which cannot support the production of hundreds of millions of dollars of unregulated product sales in MO. HOAX #1

INTENTIONALLY LABELING MARIJUANA FLOWER AS HEMP

Unscrupulous producers and retailers label products as hemp or THCa, but are really just selling marijuana that is fully intoxicating and tests above the 0.3% THC threshold for hemp.

53 of the 55 tests (96%) tested as intoxicating marijuana, with total THC levels well above the .3% threshold for hemp. And most didn't just barely cross the line, but instead contained total THC between 10-80%+ THC range. In fact, one product labeled as THCa and sold in KC actually tested 89.3% THC, meaning it contains 298 times the legal limit. And yet, it can be sold untested, untaxed & unregulated to Missouri children.

WHAT WAS HEMP IS NOW A HIGHLY POTENT DESIGNER DRUG

The DEA considers any synthetic version of THC federally illegal, regardless of its origin.

Synthetically produced and chemically converted designer drugs are being labeled and packaged as hemp products available at gas stations, c-stores and unregulated retailers statewide. Don't be confused, these synthetic drugs are highly potent and highly dangerous with products testing over 1000mg of THC or other intoxicating cannabinoids.

What may have started as non-intoxicating CBD, has since been chemically converted and manipulated to create highly potent and intoxicating synthetic cannabinoids like Delta 8 THC. Delta 10 THC. THC-P. THCO Acetate. HHC and others. More than 50% of the non-flower products purchased as part of the Missouri Hemp Hoax fit the synthetic THC category.

Often times building owners, banks, credit card processors and insurance companies have no idea their services are being leveraged to sell marijuana or synthetic marijuana products, exposing those companies to unknown risks.

CONCLUSION

Sometimes the biggest lies are hiding in plain sight. With each passing month, more and more unscrupulous actors are flooding the market with unlicensed marijuana and calling it hemp, or selling packaging attractive to children but contains intoxicating designer drugs in the name of hemp. The deceit goes beyond just products with many smoke shops and vape stores calling themselves a "dispensary" to further confuse patients and consumers into believing they are licensed and selling safe products.

This summer, we hired certified Missouri testing labs to show what's actually in these products. The fact that 96% of the unregulated, untaxed "hemp" products we tested actually contained more than the legal .03% THC limit, should be a wake up call to parents, policymakers, law enforcement, public health officials and educators.

This hemp hoax report proves that existing Missouri and federal laws are being violated on a daily basis and endangering the health and safety of Missourians.

FINAL TESTING RESULTS

53 of 55 products (96%) tested well above the .3% threshold for hemp.

Most products contained total THC between 10% - 80%+.

16 of 55 products, (29%) failed for dangerous contaminants like heavy metals, pesticides, or residual solvents.
